Burnham in the Spotlight: The Burnham Transportation Plan of Chicago: 100 Years Later

In 1909, Daniel Burnham, internationally famous architect and planner, was a principal author, along with Edward Bennett, of the Plan of Chicago, which made recommendations on how the city could grow and improve the quality of life for its residents in an orderly fashion. Many of Burnham's suggested solutions were carried out in some form or another. For example, the Plan resulted in North Michigan Avenue becoming one of the world's great boulevards. It also resulted in the double decking of Wacker Drive and the construction of Navy Pier and Grant Park.

To put the Plan in proper perspective, Chicago was one of the fastest-growing urban areas in the world during the 19th century. Its population grew from approximately 100 people in 1812 to 1.7 million in 1900. The rapid growth resulted in congestion, chaos, poverty and air and water pollution. Burnham envisioned a city of organized beauty and efficiency similar to the "White City" he helped create as a part of the Columbian Exposition in Chicago in 1893, celebrating the anniversary of the discovery of America.

Eighteen pages of the 164 page Plan were devoted to Chapter V, "Transportation: A Freight Center: Grouping of Passenger Stations: A Loop System" covering transit, freight and intercity passenger train terminals. The freight and passenger transportation recommendations in the Plan addressed such issues as improving downtown circulation, consolidation of railroad passenger terminals, reducing freight congestion, and elimination of rail grade crossings. Some of these recommendations resulted in immediate action plans. Others, like the consolidation of all intercity passenger trains, did not occur until 1971 when Amtrak operated all passenger service at Union Station.

What are some of the transportation Plan's impact on The Magnificent Mile?

-State Street, now Red Line CTA subway. The recommendation to build the subway did not begin construction until 1939.

-Improved circulation. The current CTA bus network had its origins with the original Chicago Surface Line streetcars. The proposal to put Light Rail on Carol Avenue would connect North Michigan Avenue and the commuter rail stations.

-Improved downtown delivery. The plan recommended limiting deliveries to off peak hours, an issue of current debate. Parking and loading zone problems also continue to challenge planners.

-Reduced freight congestion. The \$1.5 billion Chicago Regional Environmental and Transportation Efficiency Program, known as CREATE, was developed to reduce freight congestion in our region, the nation's rail hub.

-Consolidation of railroad terminals. The Plan proposed two railroad depots, one along Canal Street, the location of the Ogilvie and Union Stations and one along Roosevelt Road, which was never built.

-Bold plans. The rich history of our region has experienced many innovative plans, including the Chicago Central Area Plan, the 2016 Olympics and Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning GO TO 2040. One could argue these are an outgrowth of the planning first inspired by the Burnham Plan of Chicago.

Burnham's ultimate legacy was to provide common sense, vision and advocacy to the region's planning that set the stage for the vibrant Chicago we enjoy today.
