Dear GNMAA Member:

Security is always an issue, even if you manage a business in one of Chicago's safest neighborhoods.

As has been publicized by the news media, several isolated incidents of crime on and near North Michigan Avenue over the past several months have elevated everyone's concern. GNMAA has worked with the 42nd Ward Alderman's office, the 18th District Police, and business owners in affected areas to ensure that everyone benefits from the experience of

others, the Police stay informed, and the Alderman is equipped to take action should he feel that it is appropriate.

As is the case with most issues, everyone can play different roles to affect change. Business owners can check their security manpower, practices, and equipment. The Police can review their resources and personnel assignments. And the Alderman can bring the substantial resources of his office to coordinate efforts and influence policy.

GNMAA members have taken security issues very seriously and many appear to have set in motion sustainable practices to deter crime. The 18th District, under the leadership of Commander Steve Georgas, is placing new focus on the visibility of patrolmen on Michigan Avenue and other enforcement issues, and Alderman Brendan Reilly has assigned a specific staff person to work with GNMAA on the role of City government.

Every GNMAA member is urged to stay aware, even if your business has not experienced a serious security problem. I am pleased that most of our larger hotels, restaurants, and retailers have provided their employees with training in preventing crime and what to do when it occurs. Smaller businesses that haven't should periodically take time to do the same.

It is critically important to every business in our region that the public perceive the environs of North Michigan Avenue as being a safe place to visit, shop, enjoy fine dining, and experience premier hospitality. This can only be achieved if every business owner, manager, and employee joins with the Police and representatives of City government to maintain awareness, report incidents, and follow through with prosecutions.

We can take a great deal of pride in how safe our area is now, but we have to work to keep it that way. Security is always an issue and it is important that we always remember that.

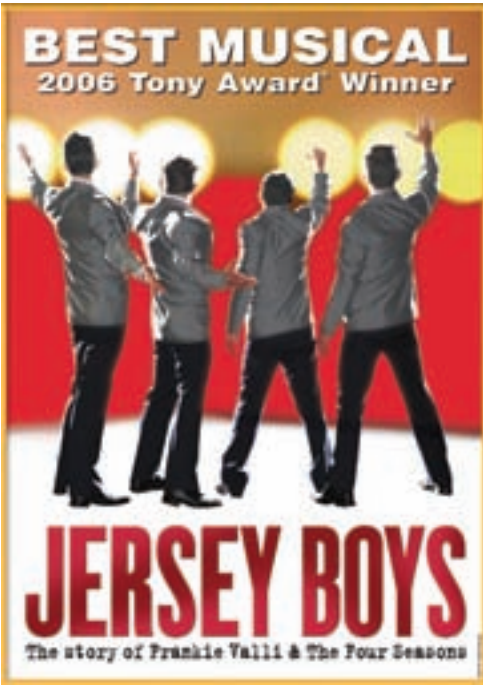
